BRIGHT ANGEL (Trail) begins on the North Rim of the Grand Canyon and follows a winding course reaching the Colorado River in 9.5 miles and 4,460 feet down. The trail was originally built by the Havasupai people for access to the water source of present-day Garden Creek. History is unclear as to the naming rights but many credit John Wesley Powell, first man down the Colorado River in 1869, upon finding this beautiful clear creek next to the then muddy Colorado River, "we concluded to name it Bright Angel." *Bright Angel* Wine is made from grapes produced from the Brianna grape and fermented in stainless steel and produces a beautiful, bright wine with aromas of peach and pineapple. Enjoy it cooled with cheese.
